(B) Conduct of National/Regional meets in Universities/Colleges.

The major events in 49th KVS National Sports Meet have been conducted in Universities/Colleges which have required infrastructure and lodging boarding facilities. Base on the feedback received by KVS(HQ), it is found that these arrangements has been widely appreciated by all the stack holders. Therefore, KVS(HQ) proposed that all Regions should explore the possibilities of conducting of Regional/National events in the Institutes.

Item 4 Online entries:

First time online entries have been made for all the participants of 49th National Sports Meet through in house software developed by Bangalore Region. The system worked very well and helped in reducing duplication of paper work and corrections. It also helped in ensuring transparency and real time and date and timely announcements of results in public portal.

Item 5. Tentative Schedule for 50th KVS Regional and National Sports Meet 2019-20.

a) Proposed calendar of events is given below :-

- Vidyalaya level - upto December 2018
- Regional Meet - upto 30th April 2019
- National Meet - upto 30th June 2019

b) Conduct of Regional Meet

- Cluster meets should be avoided before the Regional meets.
- Pattern of play :
 - * If the number of teams are 7 or less than 7, matches should be conducted on league basis.
 - * If the number of teams are 8 or more than 8, league cum knockout system should be adopted.

C) Conduct of Coaching Camp :

I. Upto National level

- The Deputy Commissioner of the concerned Region will decide the conduct of coaching camp in team/individual events depending upon the local conditions.
- Students may exempted from coaching camp in individual events, if requested by the parents.
- Students may be permitted to travel alongwith the parents and to stay outside during the meet on their own expenses.

II SGFI Level :-

KVS(HQ) will decide the venue and other modalities for conduct of coaching camp.

Item 6. Journey Plan

In order to provide safe and comfortable journey, the KVS has initiated a number of reforms i.e allowing students to travel in 3-AC/2-AC and now by air as well. It is painful to state that even after giving facilities, some Vidyalayas could not avail the best facilities and their contingents through train in sleeper class.

Item 7. Introducing new events

The year 2019-20 will be the 50th year (Golden Jubilee year) of sports in KVS, Hence, KVS proposed to introduce the following new games in this Golden Jubilee year :

- Boxing U-14 &17 (Girls)
- Cricket U-17 (Girls)
- Wrestling U-17 & 19 (Girls)
- U-14 Cricket (Boys) School Team.
- Gymnastics U-14, 17 (Boys & Girls).
- Archery – Compound events (Girls & Boys).

Item 8. Re-organization of U-19 age group for Sports Meet.

It is felt over the years that in the age group of U-19 only students of class 12th and some of class 11th are selected for SGFI participation but due to their academic pressure/Board examination many of the students drop out at the last moment which has adversely affected the performance of KVS in SGFI. Therefore, KVS proposed to replace the U-19 group in team event with U-17 age group.

Item 9. Review of grace marks awarded for sports achievements in promotion to the higher class (Class VI to IX & XI).

In the existing system the students who have participated in SGFI National level is given 10 marks in promotion in internal examination. KVS proposed, to give different grace marks for participating at different levels. It will encourage the students to take part in more sports activities. The details of proposed grace marks to be given as under :

Item 10. Review of Qualification for engaging Sports experts in Vidyalaya

In order to nurture the talent of the students in sports, there is an urgent need to provide them coaching by the experts who have the exposure of playing at International/National or the person who possesses diploma in coaching/six week certificate course in coaching in particular event/BPed degree. KVS proposed to constitute a committee to look into this matter and gives its recommendations.

Item 11. Review of DA for Staff during KVS Regional/National/SGFI Sports meet at Venue.

It is observed that the lodging and boarding is provided to Escort teacher at par with the DA of students i.e Rs.400/- per day. The escort teachers are provided free boarding and boarding during stay at the venue.

As per the 7th Pay Commission the DA of Escort teaches has increased to Rs.800/- per day. It is proposed that the DA may be charged from Escort teachers at the venue and receipt may be given to the concerned teacher.

Item 12. Submission of Expenditures of Regional Sports Meets/National Sports Meet/SGFI meet and coaching camp for re-imburement.

Regional Office provides advances for conducting Regional/National Sports meet to the Vidyalaya but it is found that some of the Vidyalaya take longer period to settle the advance and submit the final expenditure statement. Hence, it is proposed that the Vidyalaya should submit the expenditure statement in the prescribed format given in the sports modalities – 2018 within a period of 45 days from the conduct of the event. No bill will be entertained after the last date of the submission.

Item 13. Fund position

As on 20th July 2018 Rs10,08,931/- is balance in Regional Sports Control Board Fund.

Item 14. Review of Swasth Bacche Swasth Bharat (SBSB Project).

The data for the session 2017-18 has been completed by the Vidyalaya and submitted to the In-charge ZIET Chandigarh. Physical Health & Fitness Profile card have been prepared for all the students and staff members. As per KVS(HQ), letter No. F.110331/01/KVS(HQ)/Acad/ SBSB/2018/863-887 dated 19-06-2018, wait for further instructions the conduct of test under SBSB programme for the session 2018-19 may be conducted after the fresh instructions received from KVS(HQ).

ITEM NO.3

ESCORT TEACHERS

The Chairman directed that the arrangements for Escorts teachers is purely responsibility of the Principal. **No Exemption will be granted at any stage.** The following must be ensured while deputed the Escort teachers :

1. The normal teacher-student ratio is 1:10, however, the relaxation for deputing additional Escort will be granted with the approval of the Deputy Commissioner, if required.
2. Medically Unfit/Physically challenged teachers should not be deputed for Escort duty.
3. Female teachers having child below the age of five years may not be deputed.
4. Consent should taken before deputing the female teachers for escorting/Coaching.

ITEM NO.4

Boarding & Lodging:

The Chairman directed that adequate arrangements should be made for Boarding and Lodging of participants and Escort teachers. The Food should be as per the Menu of Sports Modalities for the year 2018 provided by the KVS(HQ) New Delhi .

ITEM NO 5

The Chairman directed that Cash awards as per the Sports Modalities 2018 should be given to the winners in **49th KVS National Level Meet, 64th SGFI and other tournaments.** The cash award will be distributed in the Vidyalaya based on the list of winner for cash Award provided by the host Region(s). The award will be distributed to the winners(students) in a befitting manner i.e on the occasion of Annual Day/Sports Day/in any other function.

The Expenditure of the cash award for winner of 49th KVS NSM 2018 initially will be incurred from VVN of concerned vidyalaya of student and which will subsequently be reimbursed form the Regional Office fro RSCB.
